- Every month a '**Virtual Book Fiesta**' will be organised for each class, wherein the students, after having read the book, will be engaged in a plethora of activities such as:
 - Role-Play
 - Book discussion
 - Reading excerpts
 - Webinars and panel discussions.

Student participation will be recorded and will help enhance their academic portfolio through recognitions and acknowledgement of participation in these activities.

- The students who have not read the book, will also be encouraged to join in as spectators and experience the excitement! This will certainly motivate and inspire them to read the next title that would be announced in the upcoming month.

Through this widespread reading campaign, we endeavour to provide an opportunity to our students to enhance their skills. We look forward to your support and cooperation in our endeavour to groom self-directed learners, avid readers and future leaders!
